In fiscal year 2017 Community Action Agencies served 301,206 of individuals and 120,813 of households.

Of those households:

- ♥ 31.69% of families are at or below 50% of poverty
- ♥ 14.58% of families are at 51% - 75% of poverty
- ♥ 16.75% of families are at 76% - 100% of poverty
- ♥ 14.81% of families are at 101% - 125% of poverty
- ♥ 11.68% of families are at 126% - 150% of poverty
- ♥ 6.61% of families are at 151% - 175% of poverty
- ♥ 1.64% of families are at 176% - 200% of poverty
- ♥ 2.20% of families are at 201% + of poverty
- ♥ 0.04% Unknown/Not Reported
