WIC Dietitians serve as the competent professional authority for determination of WIC program eligibility and certification, providing nutrition education to WIC clients. A WIC Dietitian will perform duties including certifying or denying participation in the program on the basis of nutrition risk, coordinating and assuring nutrition education to all participants, and providing leadership and coordination of clinic activities and report to Program Director as directed. Staff must exhibit good communication and problem-solving skills.

This is a 25-hour per week, year-round position that will involve traveling in an Agency vehicle.

Preferred Skills :

WIC Dietitians must be an appropriate role model for children, parents, and staff while also having the ability to work with children and families from various cultural, economic, and social backgrounds. Candidates must be willing to become licensed in the state of Iowa and be a Registered Dietitian or be eligible to take the registration exam and they must be comfortable using computers and other technology.
