

Early Head Start Lead Teacher – Iowa Falls, IA

Required:

- Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education or Child Development (**classified as Early Head Start Non-Supervising Lead Teacher 3**). Preference given to candidates with experience teaching preschool-age children.

OR

- Bachelor's Degree in Education with an Early Childhood Education Endorsement (**classified as Early Head Start Non-Supervising Lead Teacher 3**). Preference given to candidates with experience teaching preschool-age children.

OR

- Bachelor's or advanced degree and coursework equivalent to a major relating to early childhood education (such as the Child, Adult and Family Services Degree with Child Option at Iowa State University), with experience teaching preschool-age children (**classified as Early Head Start Non-Supervising Lead Teacher 2**).

Will consider:

- Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education or Child Development (**classified as Early Head Start Non-Supervising Lead Teacher 1**) with infant, toddler, or pre-school teaching experience. Preference given to candidates with infant or toddler teaching experience.
- Current or former MICA employee with a Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential, Infant-Toddler, and 2 years of experience in MICA Early Childhood Programs (**classified as EHS Non-Supervising Lead Teacher CDA**).
