Mission

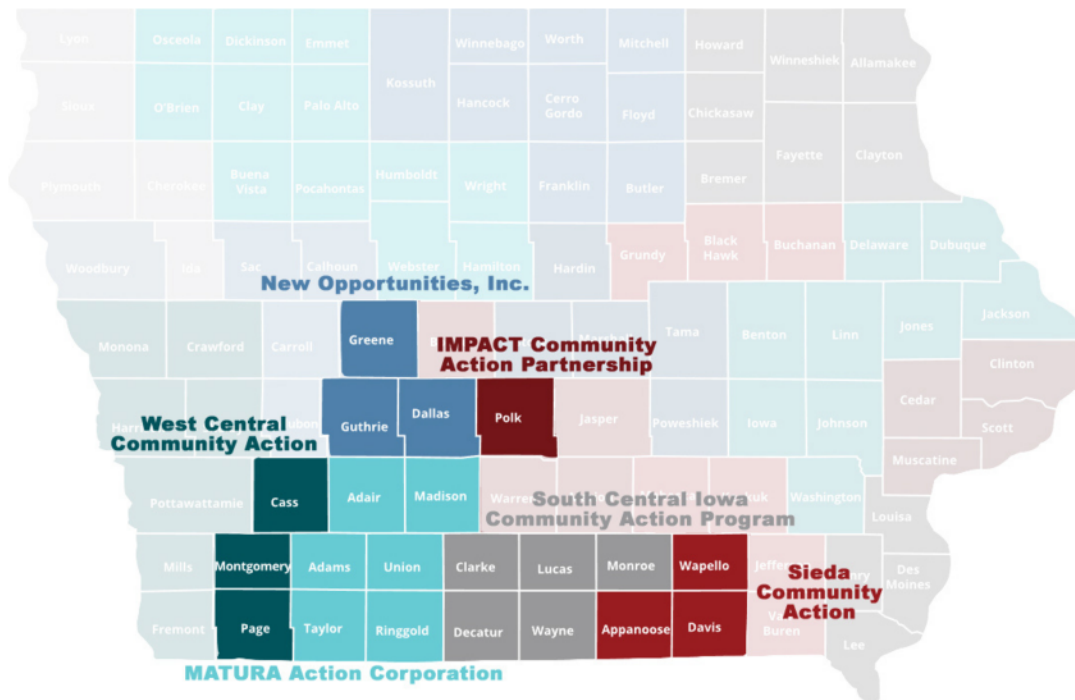
Educating, advocating for, and connecting Community Action Agencies to amplify a unified voice in service of Iowans facing economic hardship.

CSBG is a federal block grant which funds the operations of a state-administered network consisting of more than 1,000 Community Action agencies nationwide.
